STEM Festival

The Northeast Iowa Family STEM Festival will take place on April 24 at the Fairgrounds in Waukon.

Scale-Up Programs

Thirteen programs were selected to be scaled during the 2025-26 academic year. Beneke provided a summary on each program and noted ten programs are new to the menu this year. Two of the 13 programs are delivered by Iowa organizations.

The 2025-26 Scale-Up educator application opened January 7 and closes March 3. The board discussed marketing strategies.

Each Program Provider will host several 20–30-minute informational webinars between now and the application close date. Board members are welcome to attend.

Scale-Up Timeline:

- January 7 Application opened
- March 3 Deadline for an educator to apply for a Scale-Up program.
- March 5 22 Advisory Board reviews applications.
- Week of March 31 Board meeting to discuss applications and recommend awards.
- April 4 Awards are announced to educators.

The Scale-Up application submissions will occur through iowagrants.gov.

The Board discussed the priority list for recruitment and the evaluation rubric.

STEM Teacher Award

The STEM Council received 118 unique nominations statewide, including 26 from the Northeast region. Of those 26 nominees from the Northeast, 19 teachers (73%) applied for the IOWA STEM Teacher Award.

Award recipients will be announced in January and honored at STEM Day at the Capitol on February 12.
