## **Meeting Summary**

Doreen called the board meeting to order at 10:40AM.

### **Updates from the Iowa STEM Council**

Across Iowa, the Hubs received a record number of requests for Scale-Up programming. This summer, the externship program will have 80 teachers participating. The next Summit will be held September 25 in Des Moines. The Council is still transitioning from the University of Northern Iowa to the Iowa Department of Education. STEM Day at the State Fair is August 20.

#### **STEM Council STEM for All Committee**

Anderson noted the committee continues to meet, but nothing new to report.

### **Budget/Expenditures**

As of April 30, 2023, the fiscal year 2023 year-to-date expenditures for the Northeast STEM Hub are approximately \$921,000 (approximately 92% of the overall budget).

Jeff presented the FY2024 budget draft. The Northeast Iowa STEM Hub budget for Scale-Up and STEM festivals will be \$680,167.

## **Scale-Up Programming**

Jeff shared the list of virtual and in-person trainings offered this summer to educators awarded Scale-Up programs. Board members are invited to attend anyone of the training sessions. Please let Jeff know if you are interested in attending a session.

Jeff shared a document showing the number of applications submitted and awarded by organization/school. The Hub received applications from 26 new organizations. The Hub awarded Scale-Up programs to 136 of the 269 applications.

## **STEM Festivals**

The Cedar Valley Family STEM Festival occurred March 21 at the UNI-Dome in Cedar Falls. The festival had 66 exhibits and had 1,627 participants. The festival report was presented to the Board.

The Dubuque Area Family STEM festival was held April 20 at Clarke University in Dubuque. The festival had 37 exhibits and had 1,180 participants. The festival report was presented to the Board.

Jeff shared a map of the region which identified the location of all past STEM festivals conducted by the Northeast Iowa STEM Hub. Future festival locations will be discussed during the next Board meeting.
